



The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers invites you to visit Canton Lake, the key lake of a three-lake system authorized within the North Canadian River Basin consisting of Canton, Fort Supply and Optima Lakes.

This 7,900 acre lake offers extensive opportunity for outdoor recreational activities. Its gently sloping sandy beach is an open invitation for swimmers and sunbathers. Water skiing is popular on the broad expanse of water paralleling the dam where winds are subdued. The lake is famous for its walleye fishery and also provides excellent hunting and boating opportunities. For your enjoyment, campsites and picnic facilities are conveniently located at several parks around the lake. Services and supplies are available from businesses in the towns of Canton and Longdale which are only a couple of miles from the lake. The Overlook Cafe, is a commercial concession, located at the south end of Canton Dam.
