


# GENERAL HUNTING INFORMATION

## OPTIMA LAKE

Hunting at the Optima Lake is in accordance with applicable State and Federal fish and wildlife regulations. Unless otherwise posted, hunting is permitted in designated project hunting areas with rifles, shotguns, handguns, primitive firearms and bows and arrows. Generally, all project lands are open to the public for hunting except developed recreational areas and lands around the dam and other structures.

Persons wishing to construct duck blinds on project lands or obtain the current hunting regulation must contact the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation, 1801 N. Lincoln, Oklahoma city, OK, 74105 (405) 521-7239.

Hunters using the Optima Lake are urged to exercise the basic rules of good sportsmanship, safety, and common sense.

Vehicles may be driven only on established roads and trails, and camping is restricted to designated sites.
