

HUNTING GUIDE

ROBERT S. KERR LAKE

Hunting at Robert S. Kerr Lake is in accordance with applicable Federal and state fish and wildlife regulations. Generally, all Corps lands are open to the public for hunting except developed recreational areas and lands around the lock & dam and other structures.

Hunters wishing to obtain current hunting regulations or construct duck blinds on Corps lands must contact the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation, 1801 N. Lincoln Blvd, Oklahoma City, OK 73105 (405) 521-2739. Duck hunters must obtain a permit from the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation prior to constructing duck blinds. Blinds must be removed at the close of waterfowl season.

Hunting on the Sequoyah National Wildlife Refuge is permitted only during special seasons and under restrictions set by the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service. For more information contact the Sequoyah National Wildlife Refuge, Box 39B, Sallisaw, OK 74955, (918) 773-5251.

Hunters are urged to exercise the basic rules of good sportsmanship, safety, and common sense.

Vehicles may be driven only on established roads and camping is restricted to designated sites.



RESTRICTED HUNTING

As the result of cooperative arrangements between the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation and the Tulsa District Corps of Engineers, several tracts of Corps lands have been made available to sportsmen for restricted hunting. With the exception of the special restrictions outlined below, all provisions of the Oklahoma Hunting Regulations for Corps of Engineers lands are applicable on these areas.

The following areas are open for hunting of all species which may legally be taken during legal open seasons by archery equipment and all legal firearms other than centerfire rifles and handguns. Muzzleloaders and shotguns with slugs are allowed.

- 1) A 90-acre unit in Little San Bois Creek Public Use Area.
- 2) A 145-acre unit south of the Cowlington Point Public Use Area.
- 3) A 160-acre unit on the eastern portion of Cowlington Point Public Use Area.
- 4) A 200-acre unit on the southwestern portion of Short Mountain Cove Public Use Area.
- 5) A 135-acre unit in the Applegate Cove Area.
