The largest building project completed by the Tulsa District during World War II was the \$60 million Oklahoma Ordnance Works, built in 1942 between Chouteau and Pryor, to manufacture military explosives such as TNT. In 1946, the OOW was declared surplus. The asking price was determined by Meryl Lindsey, Bill Stone, and Lee Hogue.*
