This letter is to continue consultation pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (54 U.S.C. § 300101), as amended, and its implementing regulations, 36 CFR Part 800, for the subject project located in Sections 3 and 12, T 11 N, R 2 W, and Sections 7 and 10, T 11 N, R 1 W, Midwest City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma.

On January 20, 2025, the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) submitted to your office a report of results of pedestrian survey with shovel tests conducted by Stantec in November of 2023 titled *Archaeological Survey Report for the Midwest City proposed Timber Ridge Project in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma*. They identified no historic properties in the project's area of potential effect (APE). USACE received a comment letter from your office dated February 20, 2025, requesting additional information and Historic Preservation Resource Identification (HPRI) forms for the standing structures indicated in Project Areas 2, 3, and 6 of the proposed project.


Please find enclosed the requested HPRI forms and a letter report of the survey of the built environment in the project APE conducted by Stantec in June 2025. Stantec identified six historic age (45 years old or older) built environment resources in the APE, all of which are part of the Midwest City Water Filtration Plant in Areas 3 and 4. Stantec recommends all surveyed resources **not eligible** for the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) either individually or collectively.

USACE concurs with the recommendations in the report and, based on the current information, we find that there will be **No Historic Properties Affected** (36 CFR 800.4(d)(2)) by this undertaking as currently planned.


Please provide completed Historic Preservation Resource Identification Forms and appropriate photographs for each structure 45 years old or older to be affected by the project.

This agency received the above-referenced cultural resources survey reports of investigations regarding the proposed Midwest City Timber Ridge Project for review and comment. From the information provided, we understand that Stantec Staff surveyed multiple locations totaling 15-acres of the overall Area of Potential Effects (APE) on November 21-29, 2023. No archaeological sites were documented. USACE recommends a finding of *No Historic Properties Affected*.

I concur with the findings and recommendations as they pertain to prehistoric archaeological resources and defer opinion on overall project effects to the State Historic Preservation Office.
