## USACE Annual Passes - Including AtB Annual Passes Plan for Extension of Expiration Dates to Mitigate Lost Use by Visitors Due to the Coronavirus Pandemic

## Background:

All sales of the USACE Annual Pass (plus America the Beautiful Annual Passes) have been suspended by April 2020.

Because of the suspension of fee collection and the closure of areas by many agencies, sales of Interagency Annual passes were suspended on the USGS website during the week of March 23, 2020. USGS continues to sell/issue the Lifetime Senior Pass and Access Pass. Field sites were advised to suspend sales and most have done so, including our Tulsa Lake Offices. ## 1. USACE Annual Passes.

We have extended the expiration date of USACE Annual Passes (\$40) that were purchased/valid during the period April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020 by continuing to accept them for SEVEN months after the expiration date on the pass. This is based on the currently planned date of 1 Oct 2020 to resume collecting user fees (day use fees). This does not apply to campgrounds. As campgrounds begin to open applicable camping fees will be charged. No action is needed except to view the expiration date on the USACE Annual Pass and use Table 1 below to determine the new expiration date. This extension period will help mitigate the inability of visitors to use their passes during the coronavirus mandatory stay-athome orders, park/recreation area closures and fee suspensions which commenced in March/April 2020. This simple solution will enable field staff to simply view a visitor's pass and automatically grant the seven month extension based on Table 1. This table will be adjusted to reflect any changes to fee collection restart dates.

2. Interagency America the Beautiful Annual Passes.

The Corps has extended the expiration date of Interagency America the Beautiful (AtB) Annual passes that were purchased/valid during the period April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020 by continuing to accept them for seven months after the expiration date punched on the pass. This extension period will help to mitigate for the inability of visitors to use their passes during the coronavirus mandatory stay-at-home orders, park/recreation area closures and fee suspensions which commenced in March / April 2020. This simple solution will enable field staff to simply view a visitor's pass and automatically grant the seven month extension based on Table 1. This table will be adjusted to reflect any changes to fee collection restart dates. Table 2 below shows the proposed broad guidance for each type of pass.
