

Report for: Hugo Lake
Time: 1530
Date: 07 June 2019

Highlights:

Elevation: 416.19 and rising
Inflow: ~13,159 (cfs)
Release: ~177 (cfs)

At 1530 the elevation at Hugo Lake was 416.19 feet msl and rising with a release of approximately 177 cfs (6 Tainter Gates closed and Low Flow Open to 50%). Normal pool elevation for Hugo is 404.5. The flood control pool is 24.45% full.

Update:

A few closures due to the high water:

Wilson Point and Kiamichi Park swim beaches are closed due to their access roads being inundated. Virgil Point sites C2 and C8 are closed due to the water coming up on their pads. All other PUA's are open and available, but increases in inflow and local precipitation could require further closures.

*Group Camp remains closed while repairs are being made to the PUA from the vandalism that occurred over the winter.

At present, all combined structures that make up the flood control operations are working as designed with no issues or concerns.

Hydrologists with both the Tulsa District and Little Rock District will continue to monitor flows and make changes as necessary. More information will follow as it becomes available.
