The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is in the process of revising the Ft. Gibson Lake Shoreline Management Plan. The purpose of the Shoreline Management Plan revision is to establish policies and provide guidelines for managing the shoreline (lakeshore) of Ft. Gibson Lake, Oklahoma for (1) the protection of desirable environmental characteristics and (2) the restoration of shorelines where degradation has occurred. Public input is especially needed regarding all aspects of the shoreline management plan, which must be compliant with the 2016 Ft. Gibson Lake Master Plan.
