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- **B.** Typical year assessment(s): During the August 4, 2020 site visit, the stream was observed not to contain water. The stream is mapped on a 7.5-minute USGS topographic map as headwaters of an unnamed intermittent tributary of Mill Creek. However, since the stream did not contain water and the APT showed that the site is experiencing wetter than normal conditions on August 4, 2020, the stream was determined to exhibit ephemeral flow.
