- C. Additional comments to support AJD: The review area is comprised entirely of dry land based on the field report included in the applicant's request. The site is depicted as having the headwater of an unnamed tributary to Choctaw Creek beginning in the Northern half of the review area, however, the field report/photos confirm that no stream channel or confined flow is exhibited within the review area. Furthermore, site soils are best characterized as deep, well drained sandy loam soils. Site photos show extensive occurrence of Eastern Red Cedar, which are synonymous with dry land.

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
