Please reference correspondence dated January 24, 2024, submitted by Eagle Environmental Consulting, LLC, concerning a request for an Approved Jurisdictional Determination (AJD). The proposed project is located in Section 6, Township 18 North, Range 15 East, in Wagoner County, Oklahoma. The area marked in red on the enclosed maps denotes the limits of the property examined under this request. We have reviewed the submitted data relative to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (CWA).

We have examined the property (map enclosed) and concluded that the referenced property contains 7 non-jurisdictional aquatic resources including:

Non-jurisdictional Pond FS-1 (0.92 acre)

Non-jurisdictional Pond FS-2 (0.68 acre)

Non-jurisdictional Non-Relatively Permanent Water FS-3 (201 linear feet)

Non-jurisdictional Non-Relatively Permanent Water FS-4 (605 linear feet)

Non-jurisdictional Non-Relatively Permanent Water FS-5 (392 linear feet)

Non-jurisdictional Non-Relatively Permanent Water FS-6 (431 linear feet)

Non-jurisdictional Non-Relatively Permanent Water FS-7 (213 linear feet)

We have concluded that these features (depicted on the enclosed map) are not jurisdictional waters of the United States. Therefore, a discharge of dredge and/or fill material within these aquatic resources is not subject to regulation pursuant to Section 404 of the CWA, and a Department of the Army (DA) permit would not be required.

This final determination constitutes an approved JD subject to the optional Corps Administrative Appeal Process. If you object to this determination, you may request an administrative appeal under Corps regulations at 33 CFR Part 331. Enclosed is a copy of the "Notification of Administrative Appeal Options and Process and Request for Appeal (RFA)" form. If you request to appeal this determination you must submit a completed RFA form to the Southwestern Division Office at the following address:



In order for a RFA form to be accepted by the Corps, the Corps must determine that it is complete, that it meets the criteria for appeal under 33 CFR Part 331.5, and that it has been received by the Division Office within 60 days of the date of the NAP. Should you decide to submit a RFA form, it must be received at the above address by April 20, 2024. It is not necessary to submit a RFA form to the Division Office if you do not object to the determination in this letter.

We believe this determination to be an accurate assessment of the presence of jurisdictional wetlands and other waters on the site which are subject to Section 404 of the CWA. This is a final determination of federal jurisdiction on the property pursuant to Section 404 of the CWA. This determination is valid for 5 years from the date of this letter unless new information warrants revision of the determination before the expiration date.

This determination has been conducted to identify the limits of the Corps CWA jurisdiction for the particular site identified in this request. This determination may not be valid for the wetland conservation provisions of the Food Security Act of 1985, as amended. If you or your tenant are U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) program participants, or anticipate participation in USDA programs, you should request a certified wetland determination from the local office of the Natural Resources Conservation Service prior to starting work.
